

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-45

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTERSON
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PROPOSITION 218 PROTEST PROCEEDING
FOR THE NEW FIVE-YEAR SOLID WASTE RATE SCHEDULE,
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025**

WHEREAS, solid waste service in the City of Patterson is provided in accordance with Chapters 6.12, 6.13, 6.14, and 6.15 of the Patterson Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Patterson City Council called and held a duly noticed protest proceeding on April 15, 2025, (pursuant to Resolution No. 2025-21), for the purpose of increasing rates, fees and charges for solid waste collection service in accordance with Proposition 218 (Article XIII D of the California Constitution) and Government Code § 53750 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in advance of the protest proceeding, a mailed notice (**Exhibit A**) was distributed to the property owners and ratepayers of record within the City of Patterson as of Stanislaus County's last equalized assessment roll and the City's latest ratepayer database; and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing, the City Council conducted the public hearing, received and considered public comments, and accepted protests delivered prior to the closure of the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has performed a raw count of the protests received, having received a total of 0 protests, and determined that the total protests received did not meet the majority protest threshold of 50% plus 1 majority protests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PATTERSON CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council does hereby accept and closes Proposition 218 public notification and protest process with receipt of less than a majority protest vote, as declared by the Patterson City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Council hereby adopts the five (5) year rate schedule for solid waste collection services in accordance with the approved rate study, attached and incorporated hereto as (**Exhibit B**).

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing resolution of the City Council of the City of Patterson was passed by the City Council at a regular meeting held on the 17th day of June 2025, by Mayor Pro Tem Roque, who moved its adoption, which motion was duly seconded by Councilmember Mora, and the resolution adopted by the following roll call vote:

Proposition 218 Mailed Notice

WAYS TO HELP LOWER YOUR BILL

Residential Customers are encouraged to use the 3-bin system as intended (Black, Blue, Green) and sort out solid waste accordingly. Higher contamination rates can increase the cost of service. Commercial customers can work with the city to assess disposal activities and customize solid waste services based on their business needs. The City Council has authorized the city to implement a low-income Senior discount program that is aligned with the **TID CARES** Program Discount.

HOW ARE SOLID WASTE SERVICES FUNDED

The entire solid waste budget is supported by the City's Enterprise Fund, which is independent from the City's General Fund. It is a separate financial and legal entity. That means the fund is not competing for the same resources that fund Police, Fire, or other City services. None of the tax revenues from property tax, sales tax, or TOT (hotel tax) come to the Solid Waste Fund. The City's fiscal policy for the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund is to conduct a solid waste rate study every five (5) years to set rates for the next five (5) years. The last rate study was adopted by the City Council in 2019 – over 6 years ago. Over 92% of Solid Waste Fund revenues are generated by solid waste rates and fee-based services.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR WRITTEN PROTESTS

Any property owner who is part of the City's Solid Waste service area or a customer of record may submit a written protest to the proposed increases to the solid waste rate increases. **Protests submitted by e-mail, facsimile, or other electronic means will not be accepted. Only one protest will be counted per identified parcel or customer.** Written protests must:

- State that the identified property owner or customer is in opposition to the proposed solid waste service rates.
- Provide the location of the identified parcels (by assessor's parcel number or street address or account number).
- Include the signature of the property owner or customer submitting the protest.

Whether mailed or submitted in-person to the City Clerk, please mark the front of the protest envelope "Proposed Solid Waste Rates." Protests may also be emailed to the City Clerk at cityclerk@pattersonca.gov with subject line "Proposed Solid Waste Rates" or can also be delivered orally at the public hearing on **June 17, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.** If, at the conclusion of the public hearing, written protests received regarding the proposed increases to the solid waste service rates are not presented by a majority (50% plus 1) of property owners of the identified parcels upon which they are proposed to be imposed, the City Council will be authorized to adopt the proposed rates. WHY AM I RECEIVING THIS NOTICE?

You are receiving this notice in compliance with Proposition 218, which requires the City to inform property owners and customers of record about:

- Proposed rate increases being considered
- The amount of the proposed rate increases
- The basis for the rate calculation
- The reason for the proposed rate increases

REASON FOR PROPOSED RATE INCREASES

The City of Patterson provides reliable, cost-effective solid waste management to ensure a clean and safe city. It takes \$4.5 Million per year to ensure proper collection, recycling, and disposal of trash, recyclable materials, and organic materials. In addition, this cost covers the City's ability to address illegal dumping in public right-of-way or bulky item collection, comply with California's unfunded state mandate SB 1383 organics recycling law, and work toward the City's goal of achieving zero waste by 2030.

Costs are increasing, and so are the requests from the community for a cleaner City. To address needs, the City Council supported solid waste rate increases as outlined within this notice. The City of Patterson continues to make conscious decisions to protect customers from high-rate increases, especially during financially uncertain times.

However, solid waste rates in place since 2019 cannot continue to sustain the increasing and essential expenses associated with current service needs and state regulations.

Continue providing garbage services that meet community needs and new recycling requirements

Update and Simplify Rate Structure to accommodate for the services required by all customers.



Meet the City's Fund Reserves Target & Add \$250K annually to account for Capital Improvements.



Continue to offer Community Cleanup Programs & Comply with State Mandates

WHAT RATES PAY FOR:

The three largest expense categories in the City's solid waste operation are Solid Waste Hauler Contract, Street Sweeping Contract, Vehicles/Equipment, Staffing, Capital, Street & Alley Maintenance, and Solid Waste Programs.



HOW WERE THE RATES CALCULATED?

The City of Patterson conducted a comprehensive Rate Study for solid waste. An independent, third-party expert prepared the Rate Study. It provides a detailed review of the City's solid waste costs, and the rate structure needed to meet those costs to support the delivery of safe, dependable, and high-quality solid wasteservices to the community. Shown below are **proposed rates** (the city bills monthly) by type of Solid Waste service and customer.
